Sailors' Society – Wellness at Sea

Blue Marine Foundation - Namibian Islands' Marine Protected Area (NIMPA) Project

Despite being Africa's second largest marine reserve, the lack of management plan for NIMPA makes it redundant. This project is working to ensure that this incredible area is managed sustainably and that it receives the protection it so badly needs.

National Oceanography Centre – Seagoing Science Bursary.
