As everyone has noted, Chinese Government is now taking measures in combatting against Novel Coronavirus Pneumonia. We have received various inquiries from our Clients on whether vessel's calling at Chinese ports would be effected due to the outbreak of coronavirus.

We have checked with China MSA and noted that no Chinese sea port had been officially announced lockdown, except for the inland river port of Wuhan, where the virus is believed to have originated.

Meanwhile, due to the end of public holidays of Spring Festival has been extended to 9th February(temporary regulation),and the ports are taking strict prevention and control measures to deal with the virus (i.e The Shanghai Zhendong Terminal request that all personnel to enter the port area must cooperate with registration, temperature measurement, and personnel without masks are forbidden to enter the port area.), the loading/discharging rate may slow down.

At current stage,please member keep close attention on crew's body health,if the crew aboard found symptom of cough,cold and fever,please report to agent,port authority as soon as possible.

Meanwhile,please member contact with agent for the latest regulation before entry into terminal and cooperate with the port authority to prevent the coronavirus influence.
