02	Dental examination
03	Visual acuity (Snellen's and Jaeger's charts)
04	Colour perception (Ishihara - 24 plates)
05	Audiometry
06	ECG (12 lead, digital)

08	Pulmonary function test (spirometry)
09	Blood typing (A, B, AB, O and Rh factor)
10	Complete blood count (automated with 3 part differential count)
11	Haematology test (ESR)
12	Syphilis test (TPHA or RPR)
13	Urinalysis (automated urine strip reader with 10 parameter urine strips)
14	Stool examination (FECT) - For food handlers only
15	Hepatitis A IgG test - If negative, a Hepatitis A vaccination should be carried out1
16	Hepatitis B HBsAg test
17	Hepatitis C HCsAg test
18	HIV 1&2 screening
19	Specific diabetes test (HbA1c)
20	Total cholesterol, LDL, HDL and Triglycerides including cardiac risk calculation
21	Creatinine test (kidney function)
22	Liver function test – AST, ALT, ALP, GGT and 5' Nucleotidase
23	Ultrasound test - liver, gallbladder and hepatobiliary tree
24	Ultrasound test - kidneys, ureter and bladder (KUB)
25	Drug screening (methamphetamine, opiates, barbiturates and cannabinoids)
26	Pregnancy test for females - Additional charge of USD 6 to be billed to manning agency
