

NPDES VGP and EU Emissions Trading Scheme Seminar

- Give practical guidance on how to influence the shape of the proposed legislation to try to secure the scheme that best suits your business model.
- II. EPA Vessel General Permit (VGP) Requirements: Avoiding the Sequel to the MARPOL Prosecutions.

- Recommended strategies for reducing enforcement risk
